Founded 1908

History

The club was founded in 1908 and was originally called Wimbledon Town Golf Club. Golf has been played on the common since 1865 when officers of the London Scottish Rifle Regiment were given permission by the Lord of the Manor of Wimbledon, Earl Spencer, to construct a golf course. In 1871, after the earl had tried to seal off the land for his own private use, the Wimbledon and Putney Commons Act was passed in parliament and control of the common was vested in a body of eight Conservators. Permission is received from the Wimbledon and Putney Commons Conservators to play golf over the common but there are certain restrictions.

Regulations

Play cannot take place on any Sunday after 2 pm and on any Public Bank Holiday. A requirement of the conservators is that all players on the course must wear a plain pillar box-red outer garment and the Rangers, who patrol the common, are empowered to stop people playing if they contravene this rule. Both Wimbledon Common Golf Club and London Scottish Golf Club are restricted in the number of members they can have.

Membership

The current entry fee payable by new members (except junior and social) is £50.00 + VAT and the annual subscriptions for the different categories due on the 1st April each year are: 7 days £800, 5 days £560, Intermediate £400, Junior £160 and Social £15. Members joining after the 1st April pay a pro-rata subscription up to the following 31st March. We have a small but active junior section (age limit 18 years) with regular competitions arranged. Also required from members is a Bar Levy of, currently, £90.00, payable on the 1st October each year. The members have 12 months to spend this amount over the bar and any amount not spent on the following 30th September will be deducted and put into club's subscription funds.

Green Fees

Green fees are welcome from Monday to Friday but can only be accepted with a member at weekends. Currently the green fees are £15.00 per round on Monday (with limited catering), £25.00 per round on Tuesday to Friday and £30.00 per day on Mondays and £35 per day Tuesday-Friday. Members are allowed up to three guests at any one time at a rate of £15.00 per round midweek and £25 per round at weekends. A member must play with his guests.
